DANCE

BROADWAY JAZZ

Introduction to jazz dance and technique. Participants will create combinations, learn dance techniques and vocabulary, and demonstrate movement elements in choreographed performances. Uniforms: Black leotard, black jazz pants or Capri pants, black jazz shoes and hair up.

BALLET

Ballerinas are introduced to a basic structure of a ballet class and vocabulary. Uniform: Black solid leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes and hair in a bun with hair net (no shorts).

HIP HOP

Introduction to hip hop techniques. Participants will create combinations, learn dance techniques and vocabulary, and demonstrate movement elements in choreographed performances. Uniform: Black leotard, any color baggy style pants (blue, pink, yellow, green)

Krav Maga is an integrated system of self-defense, combat and fighting, VIP and third-party protection, avoiding, preventing all type of violent confrontation.
