MINI ROBOTICS

Using tablets and a specialized software in an easy-to-use programming environment, kids can build, program and see their creations come to life. Mini robotics themes will cover life, physical, earth, and space sciences, as well as engineering.

KRAV MAGA

KRAV MAGA WITH KMG FLORIDA

Krav Maga is an integrated system of self-defense, combat and fighting, VIP and third-party protection, avoiding, preventing all type of violent confrontation.

The training process for kids and teens also places emphasis on the development of important personality traits such as: courage, self-restraint, self-discipline, creativity, leadership, self-confidence, ability to make decisions in stressful situations, and the understanding of when to use the knowledge.

Rewards and levels will be represented by patch system.
Uniform fee: \$75 per child.

DANCE

BROADWAY JAZZ

Introduction to jazz dance and technique. Participants will create combinations, learn dance techniques and vocabulary, and demonstrate movement elements in choreographed performances. Uniforms: Black leotard, black jazz pants or Capri pants, black jazz shoes and hair up.

BALLET

Ballerinas are introduced to a basic structure of a ballet class and vocabulary.

Uniform: Black solid leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes and hair in a bun with hair net (no shorts).

HIP HOP

Introduction to hip hop techniques. Participants will create combinations, learn dance techniques and vocabulary, and demonstrate movement elements in choreographed performances. Uniform: Black leotard, any color baggy style pants (blue, pink, yellow green)

Join our performance focused Hip Hop crew. Tryouts are required. A commitment to twice per week practices (Tuesday and Thursday) for Hip Hop Crews.

In this Musical Theater class, students will learn what Broadway is all about. They will utilize different skills such as memorizing spoken dialogue, storytelling, teamwork, and stage presence. Students will be educated on how to Dance, Sing, and Act... then assemble all their newly discovered talents for their final Showcase. Your child will have the opportunity to grow in their confidence, listen to all their favorite Pop/Disney songs, and experience what it's really like to be in a Broadway Show! Open to all levels, no previous training required."
